



## **ISA Undergraduate Arboriculture Fellowship**

The International Society of Arboriculture is offering an undergraduate fellowship in arboriculture and seeks applicants. The fellowship is open to junior or senior undergraduate students currently enrolled in a four-year program in arboriculture, urban forestry, or a related field. The fellowship will provide students with experience in diverse aspects of arboricultural education, as well as the opportunity to work with some of the leaders in arboricultural research and education from around the world.

The ideal candidate will be a student who has excelled in academic studies and is interested in continuing scholastic studies at the graduate level or is seeking future employment in a technical position in commercial, utility, or municipal arboriculture.

Candidates must be undergraduate students from anywhere in the world currently attending a four-year program with a minimum of two years completed, majoring in arboriculture, urban forestry, horticulture, or a related discipline. Students nearing completion of a qualifying program will also be considered. This is a paid fellowship with a stipend of \$10.00 per hour

The deadline for receipt of 2004 fellowship applications is March 15, 2004. Candidates will be ranked based on academic background, experience, recommendations, and expressed desire for the position. Successful candidate(s) will be notified by April 7, 2004.
